Public Comment Guidelines



The purpose of this public meeting is to provide a structured public forum for interested individuals to comment on ALCOSAN's Draft Wet Weather Plan. Public comments received will become a part of the official project record and will be included in ALCOSAN's Wet Weather Plan submission to the regulatory agencies in January 2013.

All written and oral comments must include your full name, complete address including the city, state, zip code, and the municipality in which you reside. If the comments offered represent an organization or special interest group, please include the name of the organization or special interest group that is being represented.

Individuals are invited to give their comments following the ALCOSAN presentation and the Q&A session. If this presentation is not on the meeting agenda, individuals will be invited to give their comments when the instructional segment of the program concludes.

If you are unable to stay for the entire meeting or prefer to give your comments in the separate comment area, you may do so at any time throughout the course of the meeting. A stenographer is stationed in this meeting area and also in the separate comment area so that all oral public comments are recorded.

If you have written comments, you may place them in the designated drop box at any time during the meeting.

All public speakers will be limited to three minutes for the purpose of presenting comments.

Please silence all cell phones. Please be courteous of all speakers by not interrupting, clapping or shouting out.

There will be no questions or discussion when an individual is presenting their testimony.

ALCOSAN's goal is to gather as much public input as possible on this significant regional public works project. It is important that everyone abide by these guidelines to ensure a smooth and orderly public comment process and allow all who wish to speak equal opportunity to do so.
